BAKE SALE

Last year, our bake sale was a surprising success, not to mention great fun for everyone involved. This year, we need baked goods for sale and volunteers to work the table.

If baking, we ask that you provide home baked items from the following list:

- One whole pie
- One whole cake
- One dozen muffins (individually wrapped)
- One dozen cupcakes (individually wrapped)
- Two dozen cookies (bagged - 3 cookies per bag)
- One dozen brownies (individually wrapped)
- One sweet bread loaf (bagged or wrapped)
- One loaf - any type (bagged or wrapped)
- One cobbler (bagged or wrapped)

All baked goods should be labeled and delivered to the fellowship kitchen by 5pm on Friday, April 12, or no later than 6am Saturday morning. It's predicted to be a warm day, so please avoid anything that would melt.
